3. GWINNETT JAIL APPROVALS. We have – after a period of no news – had three applicants to Gwinnett County Jail approved and they will be joining the panels on the men and women’s sides. We need panelists now who will serve in the winter and new year.

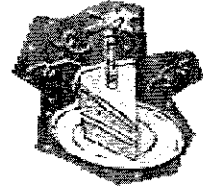
