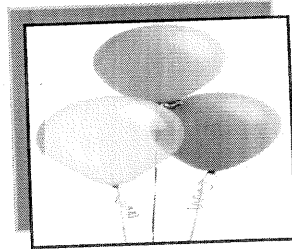

1. **FEB 9th:** *Regional Service and H&I Learning Day*
Co-hosted by H&I from East End and North Atlanta Areas

Location: First Baptist Church of Decatur, 308 Clairemont Avenue, Decatur, GA (flyer attached)

Time / Schedule: Workshops from 12pm until 6pm. Game/Karaoke Night follows free dinner (snacks and coffee will be provided all day). Workshops are: GSR Training at noon, followed by Public Relations, new Service Plan/Structure, and then two sessions on H&I.

The last will include why, how and the need for H&I outreach to jails, hospitals and treatment centers.

Needs: Volunteers on snack food and desserts for the afternoon. A small play area for children is provided. We need volunteers for 30 minute shifts to watch the kids.

2. The Georgia Region Bridge Program is now up and running. The purpose of the bridge program is to provide a "Bridge" between people reentering their communities from in-patient treatment or incarceration and their first meeting of Narcotics Anonymous. 2. Regular panel leader report that all is well in our three locations. Gwinnett County Prison still needs new 'orientation/badges;' this has to be scheduled by the prison, and progress is slow, but ongoing.

3. H&I has begun investigations into new facilities. Some targets include:

4. H&I now meets at 1:30, and is slightly shifting where they meet before Area. At Summit Ridge, we will be across the hall in the 'Group Room.' At the new Conyers location, there is a lobby that can be used by either H&I or PR. As we grow in the northern part of the East End Area, new members are stepping up. We could always use more! Stay tuned for new ways to provide service to the newcomer.

5. We need women to work in H&I. Debbie V (Panel Leader for GRAN Women) is currently the only H&I member. As we add facilities, we hope to add meetings that are either for women or co-ed.
