How to Post N.A. Related Events to the East End Event Calendar

Guidelines for GSRS, Alt.GSRS, Secretaries, Home Groups, East End Members

East End Area Members now have the ability to post N.A. Related Events to the East End Website Calendar of Events. Please keep a copy of this document with your Home Group Materials and Review the posting Guidelines with ALL Home Group Members at Group Conscience or as time and circumstances permit. The Events Calendar is to be used for East End N.A. Related Events only.

Permitted Events:

- 1) N.A. Home Group Member Birthday Celebrations
- 2) N.A. Related Special Events
- 3) N. A. Related Fundraisers
- 4) Speaker Meetings
- 5) Group Anniversaries/Group Celebrations
- 6) N.A. Retreats
- 7) N.A. Dances/Shows/Entertainment Functions

NOT Permitted:

- 1) Any Non-Narcotics Anonymous Related Function
- 2) Non East End Area Events unless Co-Sponsored by the East End Area
- 3) Group Conscience Dates/Time Changes/Format Changes/ Location Changes, etc. (These should be submitted through PR Committee or addressed at AREA by your GSR))
- 4) Events which are in Violation of N.A. Policies, Traditions & Concepts

How to Post an Event:

Please use the attached EEASC Calendar Event Posting Request Form (See Back of this Page) to submit your event using 1 of the 2 methods below.

METHOD 1: Using the EEASC CALENDAR EVENT POSTING REQUEST FORM as your Guideline, you may submit your event via e-mail at www.eeascna.org. Click on the EVENT CALENDAR TAB and click on the Green events@eeascna.org link to open your e-mail program from any computer, smart phone or tablet. Put the word EVENT in your SUBJECT LINE and ALL ADDITIONAL INFORMATION in the body of the e-mail. Click SEND when finished. You will receive an e-mail confirmation within 3 days confirming your event was received and posted to the calendar.

METHOD 2: Submit a Written Completed EEASC CALENDAR EVENT POSTING FORM to your GSR, GSR ALT., Secretary, Group Representative or any member who will be attending any monthly East End Area Meeting or ask a fellow Home Group Member with Internet Access to submit the event for you using METHOD 1 listed above.

IMPORTANT: EVENTS Submitted via TELEPHONE CALL, PERSONAL E-MAIL, TEXT MESSAGE OR VERBALLY to ANY EEASC Member WILL BE DISREGARDED AND NOT POSTED, REGARDLESS OF CIRCUMSTANCES. Submissions which are incomplete, illegible, missing Contact Person Name(s) or Telephone Number(s) or submitted late will NOT BE POSTED.

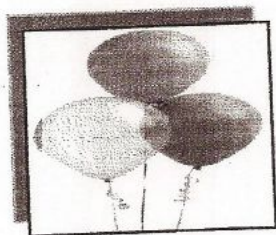

1. We have a new facility! The residential treatment New Day Living has been recommended by both PR and H&I representatives. The meetings will be at 7:30pm on Mondays. We are thrilled to announce that Calvin J will serve as Panel Leader.

We are testing a new model for some facilities. The Panel Leader will be responsible for the location each week. S/he will invite a guest speaker (or panel member) from a list of volunteers s/he recruits. Those speakers still need orientation for H&I, but serve on a more infrequent basis. It is our hope that more addicts, who cannot make a more consistent or weekly commitment, will step forward to serve in this capacity.

2. This upcoming Saturday is the Learning Day we are co-hosting with North Atlanta. East End needs to show up! The workshop schedule will run roughly in this order, starting at noon: GSR Training, then Public Relations, Proposed New Service Structure. There will be two H&I sessions beginning at 4pm, combining recruitment information and orientation skills. The day starts at noon, but ends with a free chili and hot dog supper, and a Game and Karaoke Night! (Food and fun is 6 – 9pm.)

3. Rockdale House meets on Mondays at 11am. Anyone who is available during the regular work day, and can serve when they can as a Panel Member, please contact Vic at 770-608-0404. Some of our regulars are not available right now, so we need to expand our volunteer pool for this very rewarding meeting. Great way to start your week!

4. GRAN for Women has already been working on the 'guest speaker' model for years out of necessity. (So maybe it ain't THAT new!) Women of the East End - Even if you can only share occasionally, contact Debbie, our Panel Leader, at 770-905-1222.

5. The Subcommittee is looking to add two new service positions: Secretary and Panel Coordinator. Join us for our H&I meetings at 1:30 before Area. Make your voice heard in a process of growth.
