Public Service Announcements (saying who we are & what we are) – trying to get some free tv time & get the 1-800 NA # out there, creating 4 x 4 cards for people to pick up, to place in hospital ER's, grocery stores / bulletin boards – there will be a campaign June 15th @ 10 am on Zoar Church Rd, See "Take Back to Groups section". OPEN FORUM:

-There was much discussion about if it's ok to continue putting in the same topics when they keep getting denied and discussion as to why the same topics keep getting put in (regarding Quickbooks and the purchase of a laptop computer for admin positions). Facilitator confirmed anyone can put in any topic they would like at each ASC meeting. One group announced they plan to block Topic 1308 (Quickbooks) since they confirmed through Intuit that it is illegal to use one ID for multiple users under the purchase of one Quickbooks program – which was also debated by someone who said they know for a fact that it is ok to do so when you purchase the business version.

-Discussion started by secretary concerning # of absences allowed (3 for the year or 2 in a row, unexcused) before an admin is dismissed from their position. It was discussed that most of the body believes that "Removal of Trusted Servants" should be revised in policy, since someone may have little control over that (such as during pregnancy, having a newborn baby, someone with extreme circumstances, unexpected illness / hospitalization), based on the situation but may still be extremely willing and able to serve. Most of the body agreed and a topic will be put in at next area to be voted on.

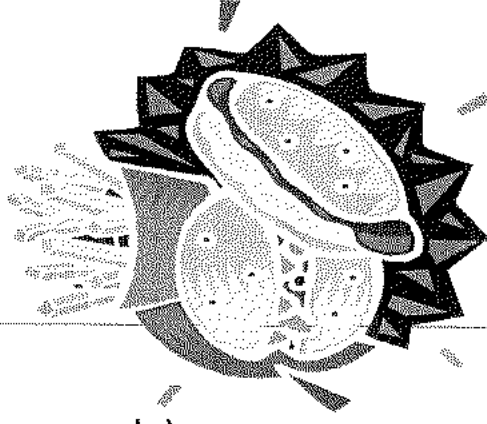

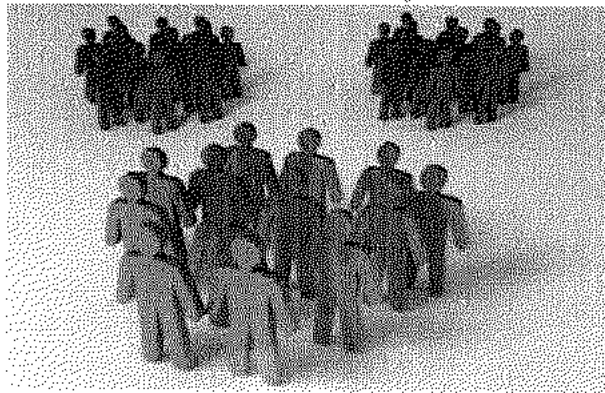
