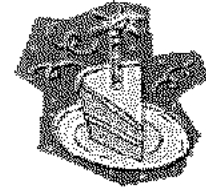

## **H&I Report to East End Area – July 12, 2013**

### **A) Volunteer Responses by H&I**

### **B) H&I Volunteer Sign-up sheets**

### **C) The Bridge Program**

This month's report focuses on this Region-wide effort to reach addicts as they leave either long-term treatment of correctional facilities. We've covered some of this before, and GSR's received hand-outs either here at Area or in the minutes. So this month, we're really pushing to get new volunteers. Region is holding off on getting info to these addicts because they don't have enough volunteers!!!

Lori passed out a version of the Bridge sign-up sheet at Area. Included here is the more recent form. We'll accept either one, but please use this one from now on. Bring them back to the August ASC meeting. Every addict with a year clean should fill out this form!

### **D) Facilities Report**

Everything is doing great! Addicts are being reached in three different types of facilities, with 15 meetings every week! To make that possible, we need volunteers!!

## Bridge Program Volunteers Needed

Temporary Contact Volunteers can "Bridge the Gap" so newly clean don't have to walk alone across that scary gap between the beginning of recovery they found through H & I meetings in facilities and the rest of recovery in NA.

We need volunteers throughout the state of Georgia as temporary contacts to help these new members! The Bridge Program uses volunteers as temporary NA contact in the area in which they are being released that can meet them at their first few NA meetings.

- No Sub-Committee Meeting Attendance Required
- Clean Time requirement is 1 year

### Do's & Don'ts of NA Bridge Service

- DO meet the member at an NA meeting within 48 hours of their release.
- DO view your first meeting with the member as you would any other 12-Step call and take another member along.
- DO explain to the member to a variety of meetings in their Area and review the many different meeting i.e. open vs. closed, book study, step study, question & answer, etc.
- DO make sure they receive an updated meeting schedule and NA literature (pamphlets)
- DO encourage them to introduce themselves and ask for phone numbers.
- DO explain group membership and the value of having a home group.
- DO explain sponsorship and refer to IP#11 - "Sponsorship." Introduce the member to potential sponsors.
- DO carry a clear and consistent NA message.
- DO help them find 2 - 3 meetings in their Area and remind them that this is a temporary arrangement.
- DO discuss any questions or problems with the Bridge Program Coordinator and/or your sponsor.
- DO keep to our basic principle when helping of men with the men, and women with the women.
- DON'T sponsor the member, even temporarily. It is important that they meet and build relationships with as many other NA members as possible.
- DON'T loan money, or provide housing, food, clothing, car, job, or any other welfare, social, or legal services.
- DON'T provide domestic or vocational counseling; provide detoxification, medical or psychiatric services.
- DON'T be involved in reports to the Justice System. Remember our 12th Tradition - Anonymity is vital!
- DON'T become emotionally or romantically involved.
- DON'T be responsible for the member's actions or attitudes - in or out of the meetings.
- DON'T accept money or gifts for your services, or any contributions from non-NA sources.
- DON'T engage in conversations about the a member's crime if they were released from correctional facility.

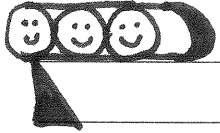

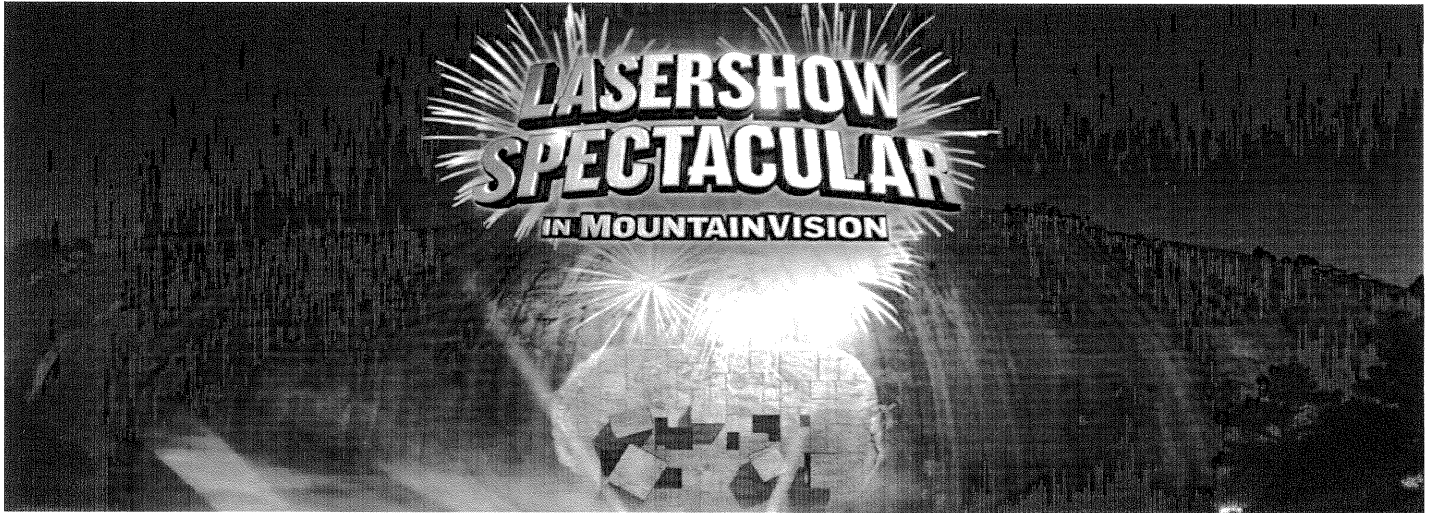

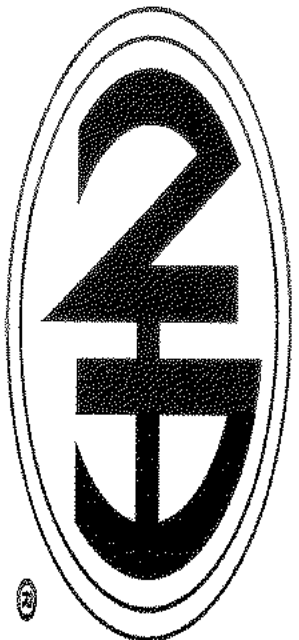
