**H&I Report to East End Area**  
**Sept. 8, 2013**

The subcommittee is now focusing on existing, long-term existing facilities. Recruitment! And orientation for incoming and enthusiastic trusted servants when they do step up.

**1. We're asking groups to stock two IP's in your literature.**

- a. "H&I and the NA Member" – IP # 20. The basics and definition of H&I.
- b. "Hospitals and Institutions Basics." (a Service Handbook – priced \$.55.) *Both* should help your own recruitment efforts. "H&I Basics" may not be part of your regular order, but we propose that a few copies on hand would be helpful.

**2. H&I Forms provided by East End Subcommittee.**

- a. A revised '*Facilities and Service Types*' is available today. It outlines East End meetings and service positions: how willingness becomes action. This new version will also be in the minutes.
- b. H&I Sign-Up sheets. Keep these around and bring them in each month or turn them in to a subcommittee trusted servant whenever you have new names. I have extras here.

**2. Please remind your members that Gwinnett County Jail is now 8pm-9:30!**

Due to the delay between application to the jail, and actually being approved by the jail to attend meetings, we must plan for the future. This means those who are willing for future availability get their applications to us now. An addict who wants to serve in October should be applying now. We're working with the jail to get a new group of applicants approved more quickly to meet current needs; we are practicing patience and pre-planning.

**3. NEW! Monthly information sessions! Short introductions to H&I in the East End Area.**

Those interested in H&I are encouraged to visit our monthly H&I meeting – on the third Saturday of the month. But new volunteers should arrive at 10:30, while the regular meeting starts at 11am.

**4. Bridge Program Update.**

Thank you all for helping us push participation in the Bridge Program. For those who need a new flyer, I have one for each of you here, and it will be in the minutes again. This version (and the one that came out in last month's minutes) makes it clear that confidentiality and anonymity are observed, and that those emerging from long-term treatment do not have your information. You have their name and phone number, and you contact them. Everything else on the form is held only by the trusted servant for the purpose of matching you with those in need. As GSR's, you are prime candidates to introduce your group to a newcomer, and it would make sense that each of you volunteer today.

Please pass up any completed forms you have now. Remember that anyone can text the word VOLUNTEER to 678-688-NAGA (6242) and the trusted servant elected by Region will respond promptly in outlining what to do next. ## Service Types

**GUEST SPEAKERS** Serve when you are available in treatment centers. H&I is forming a large pool of NA speakers who are unable to make a consistent commitment, but still want to serve. Your participation –twice a month or once a season, in one facility (or two) is based on your availability. Usually involves a 10-15 lead, similar to being a 'discussion leader' in outside NA meetings

**CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES** Many addicts in East End have requested to serve in this setting. Meetings began at Gwinnet County Jail in May, but that doesn't mean we can stop recruiting. Just ask those who've begun going into Gwinnett – this is as rewarding an experience as you can get in NA service

**PANEL LEADERS** Weekly coordinator for a meeting in a treatment center or jail; help recruit, train and facilitate a pool of Panel Members or Guest Speakers (depending on the facility)

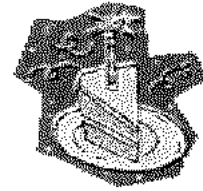

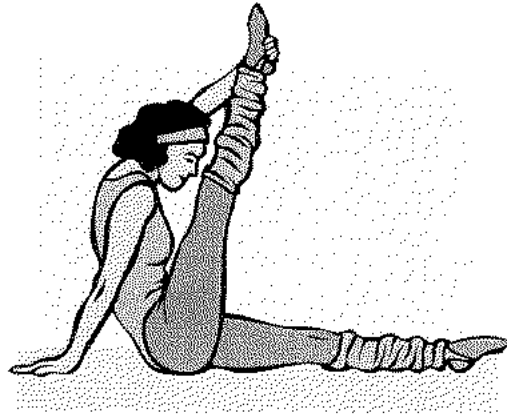
