**Intent**: To provide the RSC with the means to utilize video learning tools and presentations rather than giving to produce paper copies. The projector would also be used by the PR committee, H&I and GRCNA CPP for things like the "In memoriam" video shown at GRCNA. All video presentations that have been done were done with privately owned equipment. The majority of learning tools and session profiles being developed by the fellowship are powerpoints or flash presentations that require a projector or large video monitor to use. Based on the workshops done for the various ASC's last year, the cost of black and white copies for 17 workshops at an average cost per workshop of 67.50 each, the total spent on copies would have been \$1012.50.
