Financial Impact: The toll free number will be a Regional PR budgeted item at an estimated max of \$200.00 per month (This is with 100% of all incoming calls through the toll free number) and a minimum range of \$75.00 to \$80.00 per month (This is with 10% of all incoming calls through the toll free number). This number will direct calls to Areas whether they choose the voice over IP system or not.

Additional Information about the topic:

-Areas that choose to keep their current system will keep their current bill, with one possible exception. If an Area pays for a toll free number, that could be eliminated at the Area's discretion but a local number will be needed.

-Areas that choose to change to the voice over IP system will be charged \$30.00+ taxes per month. There is a one time set up fee of \$30.00. Also it will cost \$2.00 per month plus \$.02 per min if an Area chooses to have their own 1-800 number on top of the blanket number.
