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Topic:	To set the mileage reimbursement rate at 10¢ less than the floating 'business' rate set regularly by the government. Example: If the current business rate is 51¢ per mile, EEA shall reimburse at 41¢ per mile.
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Intent:	To make mileage rates for travel reimbursements both fair and prudent. The rate should reflect a compromise between the 'business' (currently 51¢ per mile) and the 'charity' (14¢) rates as used by the IRS. The IRS rate is a recognized standard used throughout individual and organizational reimbursement policies.
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Policy Affected	Article XII, #4, subsection e Change: "Reimbursement for auto travel will be at the current government rate for travel for charitable organizations as listed by the IRS." To: "Reimbursement for auto travel will be 10¢ below the IRS 'business rate' per mile."
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Financial Impact	EEANA current budget based is on the 'business' rate of \$.55, though policy states differently. So this should result in a small degree of savings.

March 12th 2010

- Admin reviewed Policy 2011 for submission as a topic this Region
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GSR/RCM Issues Meeting

- Marietta RCM brought up concerns about voting in Insurance Liaison without having ever seen the Insurance Policy. They feel like there are a lot of unanswered questions about whether buying insurance is something this body wants to do on a long term basis.
- South GA RCM & RCMA expressed concern about the Region seating new Areas without asking all the questions from the Guide To Local Service about the purpose of creating new Areas. They would like the RCMs to be more thorough when discussing new Areas that are splitting from existing Areas to help both Areas

OLD BUSINESS:

Topic # 2010- 29 Source: John G PR Chair REACHED CONSENSUS
Assent – 13 Assent w/Res - 1 Stand Aside – 1 Block – 0

Topic: Create a blanket toll free number for the GA Region

Intent: Provide the addict who still suffers more accurate information on meetings in a desired location and to manage NA funds more responsibly. (Tradition 5 & Concept 11)

Policy Affected: No current policy with regard to phone line.

Financial Impact: The toll free number will be a Regional PR budgeted item at an estimated max of \$200.00 per month (This is with 100% of all incoming calls through the toll free number) and a minimum range of \$75.00 to \$80.00 per month (This is with 10% of all incoming calls through the toll free number). This number will direct calls to Areas whether they choose the voice over IP system or not.

Additional Information about the topic:

-Areas that choose to keep their current system will keep their current bill, with one possible exception. If an Area pays for a toll free number, that could be eliminated at the Area's discretion but a local number will be needed.

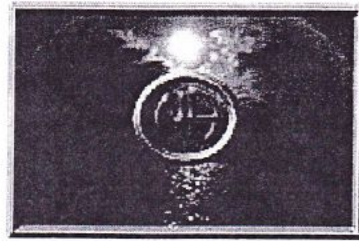

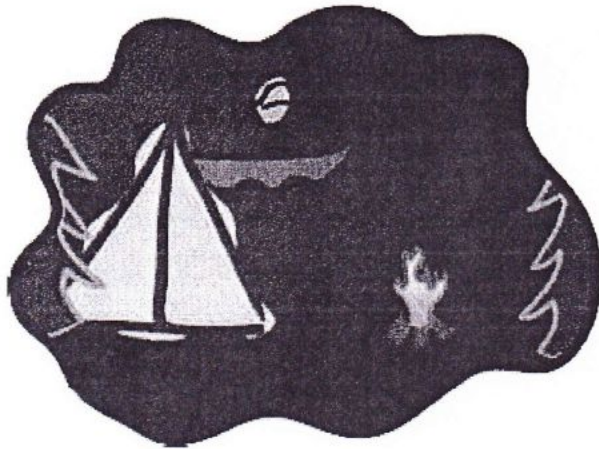
