- Questions about funds borrowed from Area being reimbursed by Activites AND questions about if Activites is holding any money at this time.
- Tiffany advised she pays some bills online, which goes around what our policy states (Yolanda also did this before her) – she will come up with a proposal to present to everyone to change this policy to reflect procedures we have been following for quite a while now. (coming soon)
- Tiffany needs 1 GSR and 1 admin member to go through and audit 2011 expenses / finances for her.
- It was brought up that the date of Feb 18th for the CAR workshop should be changed, since there are other NA functions on that day – it was decided the date will not be changed.

OLD BUSINESS

OPEN FORUM:

- It was brought up that we used to get the CAR in October and now we get it in January, which only leaves us 2 months to go through the whole report with our groups, attend a workshop, poll everyone, and relay our responses back to the regional level.
- It was discussed by many that some NA members with double digit clean time are not willing to participate in service at the area level, which is causing some of the home groups to suffer.

- Topic 2011-5 (regional level) was discussed in detail – allowing anyone to register for workshops, instead of allowing those who have already registered for GRCNA to get the first spots available.
- Naomi is running for vice-chair and Cynthia for GRCNA board pool.
- Open positions at Area level discussed and it was suggested to share with other members how our positions have helped us in our recovery, instead of pushing and asking people to serve, in hopes that we might attract more people to Area.
- Seamus announced that Stairway Group no longer has a GSR.

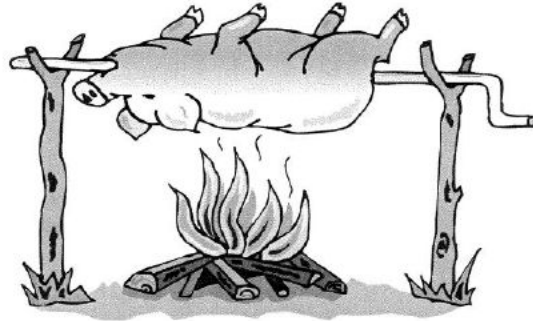
