DISCUSSED DURING REPORTS:

- Tiffany asked if she can sign Jeremy's check for mileage reimbursement; it was decided yes, since policy only states they cannot both be 'signers on the bank account' living in the same house.
- GRC INC. Board Chair Jimmy came to express gratitude for our efforts at GRCNA. He was overwhelmed at all the support and fund-raisers that came from the EEA! **WAY TO GO EAST END!!!!**

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Literature Committee Discussion:**
 - It was brought up that keeping literature on hand is costly since shipping costs quite a bit; It was suggested by a few not to establish a literature committee since we do not have an area service office or the funds to keep literature on hand; Some stated we could use Klondike as a storage unit and that we could come up with funds; It was also discussed that other areas have tried this and it has not been successful; Some disputed that they have seen it work before; One of the main concerns was that we have open positions at the area service level and we should not be adding a new committee at this time when we need to fill positions. Also brought up that 11-12 out of 25 groups come to area meetings, which is not enough to order large amounts of literature to keep on hand.
 - A suggestion instead of funding a literature committee was that we could have one person for the EEA as our point of contact for ordering literature and all groups can check their inventory

ahead of time, to allow time for shipping. This way, we would save on shipping.

OPEN FORUM:

- There was a question about why Keith (Co-Facilitator) was absent so early in his term – David stated that it was excused. Also question about if he gave a resume or not – he did not since GSR's were able to vote him into his position.
- Gratitude was expressed to area about giving our input during March's area about how to approach a newcomer behaving inappropriately / representing a different program.
- GRCNA 32 was announced – if you would like to get involved in the planning, please see the attached flyer.
- David J. announced that PR needs help getting info / updated schedules & literature out to treatment centers. He would like for more people to join the PR committee.
- (a recession was taken during area to discuss quorum and participating groups)
- It was suggested that GSR's make more of an effort to participate in local service.
- Problems ordering literature, would like to establish a literature committee (see New Business for details)
- Topic 1208 about area keeping starter kits on hand was disputed with Topic 1206, stating that new groups should be present at area 2-3 months before receiving their starting materials.



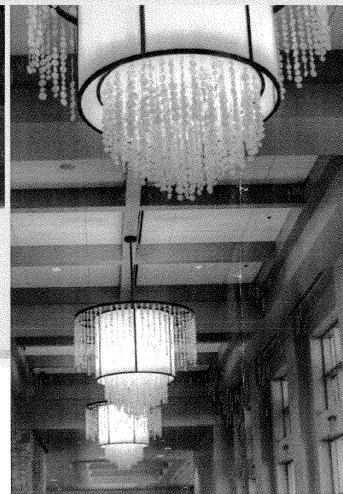

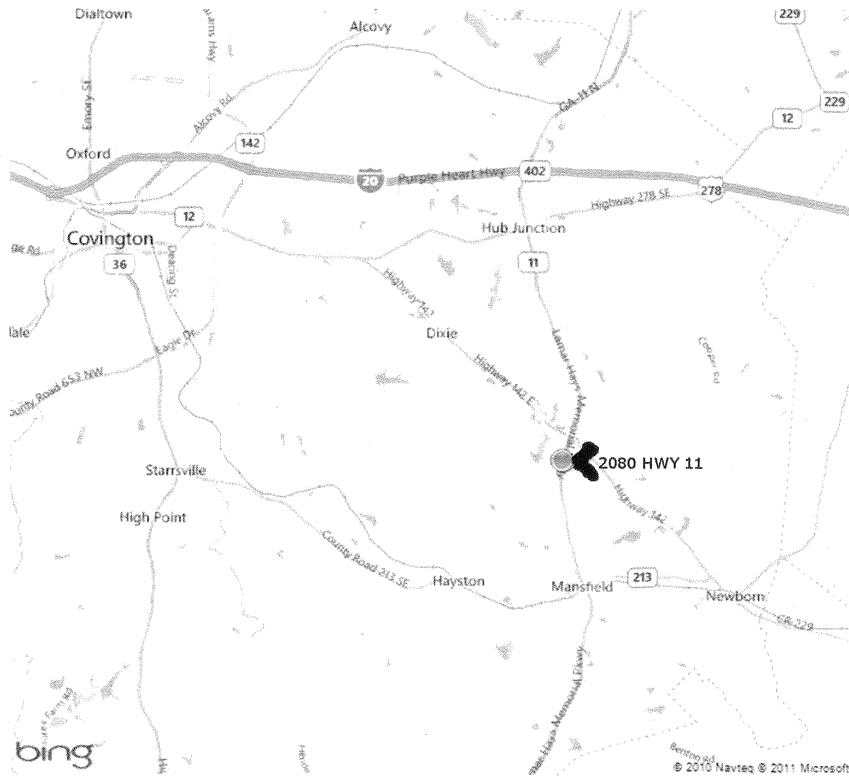
