Topic of Discussion:

When traveling to the World Service Conference meeting, the RD and RDA will receive a per diem that is 80% of the federal per diem rate for the city of Los Angeles. When traveling outside the state of Georgia for service commitments other than the WSC, such as meetings of the Southeastern Zonal Forum, the RD and RDA will receive a per diem that is 80% of the federal per diem rate for the state of Georgia.

Policy Affected:

Change to the following policy: Article 14. A. 5. RD and RDA Travel - current policy reads: "The RD and RDA will receive \$55.00 per diem to WSC meetings. \$30.00 per diem for RSC business excluding RSC weekends."

Financial Impact:

This will increase the per diem expense for the RD and RDA. For example, four days at the WSC currently provides \$220 for food and incidentals. The new policy would provide \$275.20. For other travel outside the state current policy would provide \$120 for four day. The new policy would provide \$217.60.

Suggested Solution and/or specific action (if any):

RD & RDA per diem was \$35 in 1999 to go to California - It's only gone up \$20 since then. For comparison, \$1 in 1999 is now worth \$0.51, and California is more expensive than most states. This policy change would tie per diem to 80% of the amount set by the federal government. This is how we calculate mileage reimbursement for trusted servants already - at 80% of the federal rate. This policy would mirror our mileage policy and adjust per diem with inflation.

Explanation of Changes in Regional Budget from 2025 to 2026

RSC Weekend Meeting Space – decrease of \$3,600 due to finding a new location and negotiating a favorable contract

Facilitator – increase of \$400 due to the distance from the meeting facility. By policy, individuals who live over 150 miles from the RSC meeting location can stay Friday night also. We have not been including this amount in the budget (since it is already approved by vote of the areas), but are adding, if appropriate, to account for all planned expenses.

Co-Facilitator – increase of \$87 due to further distance from the RSC

Secretary – increase of \$170 due to further distance from the RSC and to cover print cartridges for the RSC printer

Treasurer – increase of \$688 due to increased mileage and room nights since the new treasurer likely to be elected in June will be farther away from the RSC, also to cover increased cost of renewing the PO Box, as well as the cost of software, tax filing, and renewal of the new non-profit business license with the state

Treasurer-Alternate - increase of \$444 due to the distance from the meeting facility and increased mileage. By policy, individuals who live over 150 miles from the RSC meeting location can stay Friday night also. We have not been including this amount in the budget (since it is already approved by vote of the areas), but are adding, if appropriate, to account for all planned expenses

Regional Delegate – increase of \$3,940. All of this cost is because we will be sending the RD to the World Service Conference (which is now held every three years). The expense was listed last year for reference but was not calculated into the total budget. The figure is based on actual cost of the hotel room and increased costs at the location.

Regional Delegate-Alternate – increase of \$3,940. All of this cost is because we will be sending the RD-A to the World Service Conference (which is now held every three years). The expense was listed last year for reference but was not calculated into the total budget. The figure is based on actual cost of the hotel room and increased costs at the location.

H&I Panel – decrease of \$236 due to changes in mileage needs.

Public Relations – increase of \$1,100.38. The primary increase in the PR budget is to allow funding of the Vice-chair to attend the RSC and other events, along with hotel room for the GSR Assembly and Learning Days if the event is over 200 miles away.

Information Technology – decrease of \$746.44. This includes cost savings from being approved for nonprofit copies of some software and services, as well as no longer needing some technologies, but also the addition of some costs, including software and antivirus for the secretary's laptop.

Fund Set Aside for Special Topics Passed by RCMs – this is a new category where we are setting aside \$500 for topics that RCMs may pass outside of the normal budget. In addition to having this fund available if topics are passed, this will also create an appropriate accounting category for such expenses in our digital bookkeeping.

Summary

The overall total budget increase from the previous year is \$6,686.94. Sending our RD and RD-A to the triennial World Service Conference in 2026 is the primary increase of almost \$8,000, along with an \$1,100 increase for PR. Without those two expenses the budget would actually be decreased by around \$2,500.
